


## 4/4 Stormwater Authority Meeting


Stormwater Authority of Chester (SAC) had an interactive Q&A session with the board members and failed to address the questions of the residents appropriately. The EPA recommended that the City of Chester take action to solve stormwater issues, but the establishment of SAC was not mandatory.
