ENVIRONMENTAL RACISM

are practices that target low-income communities of color when building environmentally destructive industries

- Chester has the largest incinerator in America
- Chester's youth asthma rate is 5x the national average
- Chester residents suffer from higher rates of cancer, heart disease, diabetes, etc.

ASTHMA

High rates of pollution lead to increased rates of asthma. Chester's **youth asthma rate is 5x** the national average.

If you have an asthma attack,

COVANTA INCINERATOR

The Covanta Incinerator, or what they like to rebrand as "trash-to-steam," is the #1 polluter in Delaware County.

- Covanta is the largest incinerator in the U.S.
- It burns trash from NYC, Philly, all of Delaware County, MD, and Chester
- Thanks to CRCQL's constant efforts, the city recently decided to divert more than a quarter million tons of trash within the next three years

PENN LNG

Covanta incinerator attracts many other polluting facilities, like Penn LNG, the liquefied natural gas (LNG) plant proposed to come to Chester.

- Penn LNG plans to displace hundreds of residents to create a "buffer zone"
- It causes pollution and has a high risk for explosions
- Although the plan has momentarily paused, we must keep fighting for a definite cease

CHESTER WATERFRONT PLAN

- Chester residents should have access to the waterfront!
- Subaru Stadium, Harrah's Casino, and the Covanta Incinerator currently occupy the waterfront areas, blocking residents from using the spaces
- We deserve to have a voice in the decision-making process of what will happen in our community

REDUCING WASTE – Zero Waste
