Dear Mr. Piscitelli:

As a result of an administrative review conducted by the Department of Environmental Protection's Southeast Regional Office, Waste Management Program ("DEP"), following an event in the early morning of Friday, April 10, 2026 at the Delaware Valley Resource Recovery Facility ("Facility"), the DEP has determined that you are in violation of the Solid Waste Management Act, Act of July 7, 1980, P.L. 380, as amended, No. 97, 35 P.S. Sections 6018.101 et seq. ("SWMA"), and the Municipal Waste Management Rules and Regulations found at 25 Pa. Code Chapters 271 to 285, as follows:

- A. By accepting a load of waste containing radioactive material for processing that was intended to be rejected back to the generator, the facility failed to implement the approved plan for this load of waste in coordination with the Department's Radiation Protection Program, and therefore failed to implement the approved Radiation Protection Plan (Form X), incorporated in Permit 400593, approved on December 6, 2019, contrary to 25 Pa. Code Sections 283.220(a) & (b).
- B. The Facility's acceptance and processing of unapproved waste and failure to operate in accordance with the approved plans and specifications, the terms and conditions of the permit, and the environmental protection acts is contrary to 25 Pa. Code Sections 283.201(b)(1), (2) & (c).

The activities and conditions described in paragraphs A and B above, constitute violations of Section 201 of the SWMA; constitute unlawful conduct pursuant to Sections 610(2, 4, and 9) of

the SWMA; constitute a public nuisance pursuant to Section 601 of the SWMA; and may subject the offender to civil penalty liability pursuant to Section 605 of the SWMA.

You are hereby notified of both the existence of these violations, as well as the need to provide prompt correction. Failure to correct the violations may result in further legal proceedings under the SWMA. Under the SWMA, each day of the violation is considered a distinct and separate offense and will be handled accordingly.

Within 10 days of receipt of this notice, please submit to the DEP a written report addressing the circumstances under which these violations occurred, and the actions you have undertaken to correct these violations and prevent their recurrence.

This Notice of Violation is neither an order nor any other final action of the DEP. It neither imposes nor waives any enforcement action available to the DEP under any of its statutes. If the DEP determines that an enforcement action is appropriate, you will be notified of the action.
